

Jussi Björling's public performances in the United States grouped by states

This list contains several corrections and additions, compared with my chronologies included in *A Jussi Björling Phonography* (1993) and *Jussi* (1996). Unlike these, the present one also includes details about David Björling's 1919-21 tour together with his sons Olle, Jussi and Gösta. Those performances are referred to as "David Björling and Sons", as the group was then generally called. Their performances have been included only when they could be exactly dated and when there is no reasonable doubt that they actually took place. However, advertisements are the sole source for many of the 1919-21 performances and then there is a possibility that some of them might have been cancelled. David claimed after the tour that they had given about 300 recitals, Olle mentioned 250, but only 156 (in 14 states) are included here. Thus, many appearances are likely to still be missing from the list, in spite of extensive research. It is difficult to get access to relevant sources for such information, and I will always be grateful for help with the research.

A performance by the adult Jussi Björling listed as a "recital" always had piano accompaniment, a "concert" designation means orchestra accompaniment. Some of his tenor performances may also be missing, since complete itineraries have not been found for all his tours, and not for any of those before 1945.

Gösta Björling stated in his 1945 book about his elder brother, from an unspecified source, that Jussi sang in 24 US cities on his four American tours 1937-41 (all cities listed without dates). However, Gösta's list is very unreliable. 23 other cities where Jussi is known to have sung during those tours are not included there, while only 9 cities on Gösta's list have been verified from other sources. The remaining 15 cities on the list are: Atlanta GA, Austin TX, Bangor ME, Boise ID, Boston MA, Buffalo NY, Charlotte NC, Columbia SC, Denton TX, Denver CO, Hartford CT, Kansas City KS, New Orleans LA, Portland ME, Scranton PA. In three of these cities it seems especially unlikely that Jussi Björling sang during these years: Columbia (where I have tried to check all possible periods on microfilm, without result) and Denver (where a 1947 review claims that this was Björling's first performance in the city. Whatever value the list in Gösta Björling's book may have, I am grateful for comments from people who have or can find relevant information about the cities mentioned.

For almost all performances, the premises are known; for concerts and recitals the accompaniment, and for all opera performances the complete casts. A comprehensive chronology with such detailed information about Jussi Björling's whole career is constantly being updated on the website of the Jussi Björling Society (Jussi Björlingsällskapet), last time in August 2022.

As far as known, Jussi Björling sang in 41 US states and in the District of Columbia. The number of known performances is given in parenthesis after the name of a state (performances as a child + opera performances + other performances as a mature singer = total number). Opera performances are defined as staged complete performances, where Björling took part (thus excluding his *Fidelio* excerpts in Cincinnati), even if he had to be replaced during the performance (one Met *Faust*) or did not sing music from the opera (one Met *Fledermaus* gala). The total number of known US performances according to this definition is: 156 child performances + 212 opera performances + 314 concerts, recitals and other performances as an adult = 682 in all.
